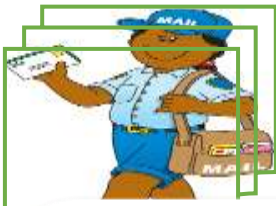

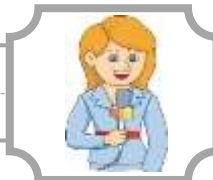

The word 'occupation' has the same meaning as the word 'job'.

A 'job' is the regular work somebody does to earn money.

When we want to know somebody's job we say:

"What do you do? (or: What is your job?)



With pronouns: (I, you, he, she, we, they)

- What **do** I **do**?
- What do you do?
- What **does** he do?
- What **does** she do?
- What do we do?
- What do they do?

We use the first 'do' to form the question.
We use the second 'do' for the profession.

The answer:

I am **a** plumber.

You are **a** teacher.

He is **an** office worker.

She is **a** policewoman.

We are construction workers. (more than one: **no** 'a' or 'an') We're construction workers.

They are office workers. (more than one: **no** 'a' or 'an') They're office workers.

Singular job names are preceded by 'a'. or an

Short:

I'm a plumber.

You're a teacher.

He's a policeman.

She's a policewoman.

The use of 'a' or 'an' with occupations (jobs)

We say:

I'm **a** teacher

He's **a** farmer.

She's **a** policewoman.

Rule: When the name of the job starts with a **consonant**

Use '**a**'

(**t** of **t**eacher, **f** of **f**armer, and **p** of **p**oliceman are consonants.)

All alphabet letters except a e i o u are consonants.

Here are the consonants:

b c d f g h j k l m n p q r s t v w x y z

But we also say:

She is **an** actress.

He is **an** accountant.

He is **an** electrician.

Rule: When the name of the job starts with a **vowel** use **an**.

(**a** of **a**ctress, **a** of **a**ccountant and **e** of **e**lectrician are vowels) **a e i o u** are vowels.

Somebody asks: "Are you a teacher?",

You can answer: "Yes, I am." or "No, I'm not."

More informal: "That's right", "I'm a teacher."
