Preposition Fun

Put 2 chairs next to each other.

Teachers/assistants first show what students must do.

The teacher/assistant has a list of prepositions (document 2).

The student starts from a certain point further away from the chairs.

At the signal 'START', the student runs to the chairs and the teacher gives the first preposition. Each student gets 2 minutes to score as much prepositions as possible.

However, after each correct preposition the student has to run back to the starting point and run to the chairs again.

If the preposition is 'on', the student will stand on one of the chairs.

If the preposition is 'between', the student will stand between the chairs etc.

Attention:

When the preposition 'over' is called, the students goes with one hand over one of the chairs.

When the preposition 'past' is called, the student walks past one of the chairs.

If the student doesn't know the called preposition he/she can voluntary run back to the starting point and run to the chairs again to get a new preposition called.

A second teacher/assistant writes down the scored prepositions on document 3.
