- 'When you come back from holiday, it's hard to work.'

Holiday**s** is usually used after the, my, your etc.

- 'Soon it will be the holidays.'
- 'Where do you want to go for your holidays?'

Distance	The amount of space between two places.

Entertainment	Shows or other performances or activities that entertain people.
Ticket	A small card given to show that you've paid for an event, journey etc.
Boarding pass	A card that allows passengers to get on an aircraft or ship.
Departure card	Official document that proves a person has left a country.
Arrival card	Official document that proves a person has entered a country.
Visa	Official mark in a passport that allows someone to stay in a country.
Voucher	A coupon that proves that you have paid for a reserved service. (hotel etc.)
